A Catalyst For Lasting Transformation


Our work is grounded in research, and we are currently conducting a comprehensive research study to further validate and enhance our approach. The preliminary data sets from this ongoing study are already demonstrating **remarkable results**. A few noteworthy findings include:

- 1. Our interventions have shown a **substantial improvement in individuals confidence** to:
 - a. remain calm during difficult situations
 - b. find a solution to a problem
 - c.to see many different solutions to the same problem
- 2. Preliminary data reveals a positive impact on their **ability to build positive communities** of support highlighting the breadth of positive changes our approach can instigate.
- 3. Our data analysis reveals a compelling and consistent pattern: participants engaging in our programs experience a significant improvement in prosocial behaviors. The evidence underscores the effectiveness of our approach in fostering positive and cooperative interactions, contributing to the overall well-being and interpersonal growth of individuals involved in our initiatives.

These promising preliminary results underscore **our commitment to evidence-based practices** and inspire confidence in the transformative potential of our work. As we continue to delve deeper into the research, we anticipate uncovering even more insights that will contribute to the ongoing advancement of our programs.

I am proud of the person I am today and can love myself fully. I have recently had the privilege of retaking the course and putting those tools back into action in my life. It has put my way of thinking on a whole new level. I am seeing my vision get closer and closer and sometimes even right there in front of my eyes there it is!! I'm living it!!! I have learned to control and influence the things that I can and give the rest to my higher power with some ease. This program has changed my life multiple times over and I am eternally grateful for the people I've met and the tools I've gained."

Who Are We?

This unique initiative empowers individuals with a dedicated curriculum designed to guide them through a reflective and transformative process.

At My Story Matters, we are passionate about being a catalyst for lasting personal transformation. "Captain Your Story" offers a structured and personalized journey, allowing participants from all walks of life, circumstances, races, and identities to take charge of their narratives.

Through a step-by-step curriculum tailored to each individual's pace, participants gain valuable tools and resources to navigate and shape their stories, creating a future that resonates with authenticity and excitement.

Your story is yours to captain, and through this process, you can embrace the opportunity to create a future that truly reflects your aspirations and values. The "Captain Your Story" curriculum helps individuals to develop purpose for their present and future life, and uncover their reasons to work towards their purpose. In this program, they explore and create an identity that fuels motivation for letting go of at-risk behaviors and relationships. They consciously make choices that help them find new communities and places that support them in a healthy manner and promote personal growth. They step out of the victim mentality and into a place of control.

This opens them up to new possibilities, a willingness to change, and a desire to use the resources that are available. All of this gives adolescents something new to hope for, and makes it so they are not reliant on other people for meaning, personal value, and fulfillment. As they go through this program, they learn to see their past risky behaviors from a healthy perspective, and see the value of creating a better life than they grew up in. Most importantly, they learn how to face challenges and

obstacles, and they know that they are in control of their lives. In time, these adolescents become willing and able to face and find the professional help they need to address the trauma that has landed them in at-risk situations.

CAPTAIN YOUR STORY

One of our big areas in the community focus has been getting our course to individuals in the Foster Care system. We met a lot of people and built a network of individuals who are leaders in this area, both in the private and government sectors, as well as those who are parents and teens who participate in Foster Care.

Our first goal was to get in and work with a group of teens so that we could know by experience what challenges they face and the help that is needed. We were able to hold a set of classes for a group of TAL individuals within DCFS.

It was a powerful experience, and each one of those individuals is continuing their journey of growth and transformation. We also were able to get a TANF grant that allows us to offer our course for no cost for those in the Foster Care community as well as at-risk youth. We have access to this grant for three years. We have made many connections within the Foster Care community who are interested in utilizing our course.

During the end of the year, our Foster Care focus led us to reaching out to the JJYS system to see how we can help kids who are in trouble. These at-risk youth can include individuals in the Foster system, and also others. So our focus is opening up to at-risk youth as well as those in Foster Care.

Another focus that we have had this last year is working with adults who are struggling with homelessness or are at risk of homelessness. We have worked with the Food and Care Coalition and are the recipients of an ARP grant that funds these individuals. We have seen powerful change and growth as we have worked with these wonderful people.

Through the past year, we have built a strong foundation of experience, connections, and resources, and look forward to continuing the work during the coming year, in these community spaces and others as well.
